Christians Help Others



All Year Groups

Your poster could show examples of Christians helping others in the past.

Research places local to Hull where Christians are helping others (such as local Food Banks, Hull Open Doors) as well as places further afield where people are being helped by Christians (Cafod, Christian Aid), these might inform what you include.

Draw, paint, copy or collage your poster to show Christians helping and serving others. You could even use a photo or drawing of yourself being helpful.
